Four Pounds, eighteen Shillings, & six pence, threefarthings, Sterling for Military Duties in 1782 per Account audited.

the said *Mr Morgan* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *Four Shillings, & ten pence*

on ~~the said~~ one Year's Interest on the principal Sum of *Four Pounds, eighteen Shillings, & six pence, threefarthings,* for and the like Interest annually

The said *Mr Morgan* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Four Pounds, eighteen Shillings, & six pence, threefarthings,* on the *twenty fifth of July 1787.*

And the said *James Morgan* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the afore said ACT.
