**Research Query** 

Searching for the parents of Andrew J. Morris, who was born in SC between 1800 and 1805. Also looking for Andrew's record of marriage to wife, Elizabeth Nunn who was born about 1805 in Chester, SC and was the granddaughter of Sheriff Elijah Nunn who died 1809 in Chester. Note: There is an Andrew Morris on the 1820 Fairfield, SC census; one of the males and one of the females in the home are in the age range of Andrew and Elizabeth Morris. As a note, my Andrew J Morris and Elizabeth (Nunn) Morris had a son in SC in 1826; they named him Lofton Nunn Morris after Elizabeth's father, Lofton Nunn who lived in Chester SC from about 1790 -1830 before relocating to AL. It is believed they had a daughter, Frances Morris. In about 1833. So I am looking for birth or other records for young Lofton Nunn Morris and his sister, Frances. It is believed that my Andrew J Morris and his wife, Elizabeth, were living in Dekalb County, GA in 1840. There is an Andrew and Elizabeth Morris living in Dekalb County, GA I'm 1850; both are 45 and born in SC.

Special Note: An Andrew J. Morris and his mother, Roda - actually should have been translated as Rosa for Rosanna - was named in an 1840 Chester, SC will of Thomas Morris; however, the age of this Andrew J Morris on the 1850 Chester, SC census is 36, making his birth 1814.

Listed with this Andrew is his mother, Rosanna, and a younger unknown female. This appears to be a different Andrew J Morris than my Andrew but I want to find records to support this.
