- son; Dowdell Murphy, 150 acres of above tract plus 50 acres after death of wife.
- dau.; Jemima Roland, shilling.
- dau.; Ann Maybin, shilling.
- all movables after death of wife divided between son Dowdell Murphy and dau. Rebecca Murphy.
- Executors: Wife, Sarah and son, Dowdell Murphy.
- Witnesses: Thomas Gordon, Wm. Chandler, Wm. Hampton Chandler.

- dau.; Martha, 50 acres where my son Robert pleases, and I owe? George Latham and desire Molly to discharge that.
