He enlisted in the Sixth Regiment on 27 August 1776 as a drummer. N.A.853.

Negro, Bob (Negro Bob)

He was a drummer in the Rangers under Capt. Samuel Wise and Col. Thomson during 1775. S.C.H.&G., II, 168.

Neighbors, Benjamin

S19000

b. 15 August 1762, Loudoun County, Va. While residing in Newberry District, he enlisted during the fall of 1777 or 1778 and served under Capt. Jeorad Smith and Cols. Williams and Pickens. In addition, he was under Captain Thomas Duggin and Col. Williams. He also served under Capt. Isaac Grier and Maj. Robert Gillam. At one time, he was under Capt. John Verdin and Col. McCrarey. Furthermore, he served under Capt. William Smith, Cols. John Thomas, Jr., Wade Hampton, and Gen. Sumter. He was in the battles at Kings Mountain (where he was twice wounded), Blackstock's Plantation, Cowpens, and Eutaw Springs. After the war, he became a Baptist minister. He served in the militia before and after the fall of Charleston. A.A.5461; V619.

Neighbors, William

He served in the militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.5462; T300.

Neil, Aaron

He served in the militia during 1782. X1123.

Neil, Benjamin

He served as a private in the South Carolina line during 1780, 1781, and 1782. A.A.5462A; N245; V402.

Neil, Christopher

He enlisted in the Second Regiment on 4 November 1775. He died on 3 October 1776. N.A.853.

Neil, Gasper, Sr.

He served in the militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.5434; T584.

Neil, Gasper, Jr.

He served as a sergeant in the militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.5434; T585.

Neil, Henry

He served in the militia under Col. Roebuck. A.A.5521.

Neil, James

He served in the Continental Line. N245B.

Neil, John

He served in the militia as a sergeant and lieutenant after the fall of Charleston. A.A.5463; V616.

Neil, John

See John Neal.

Neil, Moses

He served in the militia during 1781 and 1782. A.A.5463A; X1122.

Neil, Robert

He served in the militia after the fall of Charleston and was a wagoner during 1779 and 1780. A.A.5448; Q328.

Neil, Richard

He enlisted in the First Regiment on 21 September 1776 and re-enlisted in December 1776. N.A.853.

Neile, William

See William Neal and William Neele.

Neiley, John

See John Neely.

Neiley, Samuel

See Samuel Neely.

Neilson, Abel

He served in the militia at Stono under Capt. Robert Montgomery from 12 May to 11 June 1779. From 30 June to 18 August 1780, he served under Maj. Crawford. A.A.5524; U512.

Neilson, Andrew

He enlisted in the Second Regiment on 4 November 1775 and was discharged on 10 February 1777. N.A.853.

Neilson, James

He served three tours in the militia before and after the fall of Charleston. One tour of twenty-four days in 1781 was under Capt. Miles and Col. Taylor. A.A.5463C; P334; Q323.

Neilson, John

He served five hundred seventeen days as a captain under Col. Richardson and General Marion from 22 August 1780 to 30 November 1782 alternately. A.A.5474; Y1026.

Neilson, Kaleb

He served in the cavalry under Col. Maham from 11 August 1781 to 4 July 1782. A.A. 5465; A78; S.C.H.&G., V,117.
