

MRS. E. R. POAT DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Mrs. Alma Nelson Poat, wife of E. R. Poat, died at 3 o'clock Friday morning at her residence, 2017 Assembly street, Columbia, after an illness of eight weeks. The funeral services were conducted Saturday afternoon at the residence by Rev. C. B. Burts, pastor of the first Baptist church, and the interment was in Elmwood cemetery.

Mrs. Poat was 29 years of age.
