He was born in Orange County N.C. but before the War he removed to Craven County S.C. and settled on Mill Creek about 4 miles from Winnsboro in what is now Fairfield County, S.C. He lived here in 1835. FAMILY

JAMES NELSON was born 6 August 1748 in Orange County, N.C. and died in Fairfield County, S.C. 28 May 1835

He was married in Fairfield County S.C. in 1788 to Second MARGARET TURNER...His wife who died in Fairfield County, S.C. on the 23rd day of July 1845 or the 24th day...She died at midnight.

In 1798 the Veteran referred to "My FOUR of FIVE CHILDREN" The names were not listed.

When the widow, Eargaret Turner Nelson died in 1845 she was survived by two children...All the other children were deceased.

JESE NELSON... The second son was born 16 August 1790 He survived his mother.

PANIEL NELSON... An ther whose birth date was not listed He survived his mother.

The names of the deceased children were not given.
