The U.S. Census records, indicate that Stephen Nolan Sr. was born in South Carolina. However some researchers believe they came from Union County N.C. or the general area. This well could be correct. Since Union Co. N.C. was created from parts of Anson and Mecklenburg Co's in 1842. This was much to late for our ancestor.

Union Co. S.C. was created from District 96. (in 1790). Dist. 96 was one of the seven original districts, created when S.C. became a state 1788.

However it be, we have good reason to believe Steven Nolan was born in this general area about 1790.

Since the name of Stephen Nolan's father and mother are unknown, the earliest record's located to date are the 1840 U.S. Census. ~~in~~ Macon Co. Ala. Macon Co. Ala. Created 1832 from Creek

In 1840 Stephen Nolan was listed as married, living with wife and (9) children. (7) girls and (2) boys. Macon Co. Ala.

It is not known where Stephen and his wife were married or when.

Since one of the daughters was over 20 years old in 1840. Stephen probably married 1815-20.

Nancy Nolan probably was the oldest child <sup>of Stephen</sup> of Nolan. She married E.W. Jones, April 15, 1838. It can be presumed that she was not one of the above listed female children. Elias W. Jones married Martha Nolan, July 17, 1845, and also married the third sister Jane Sept. 3, 1846. Jane, better known as Jenny, outlived her husband many years. Elias Jones is buried in Smyrna Cemetery a few miles north of Harleton, Texas. (Harrison County) There are no dates on the grave marker (Name only)

Macon Co. Aln.

Jenny Nolan-Jones is buried in Eagle Springs Cemetery a few miles west of Smyrna Cem. The grave is unmarked; several of her children and other close relatives are buried at Eagle Springs.

Jenny and Elias Jones were the parents of eight (8) children, three (3) daughters and five (5) sons.

Elias and Nancy had two (2) sons. <sup>check</sup> or <sup>their</sup> <sub>sons</sub> descendants  
Elias and Martha had no children.

Nancy and Martha both died in Alabama. Three other children, possibly more died in Alabama or elsewhere.

Dr Joe Funderburk mentions a daughter Lucindia, probably died young.

David Nolan, born Oct. 12, 1824 S.C. and Stephen Nolan Jr. & circa 1838. were the only known sons of Stephen Sr. and his wife.

The Nolans, Jones and Gillis left Macon County Ala. after 1840 and before 1850.

Stephen Nolan Sr., Stephen Jr., Elias Jones and J. Gillis all located in Harrison Co. Tx. about 1854. I have not been able to locate them in 1850.

The 1860 Harrison Co. Tx. U.S. Census list S. Nolan - 70 yrs. farmer born S.C.

In the same house is listed S. Nolan, female, born 5.0. This 30 year old female could be an error. Stephen Jr. is not listed and is known to be in this area in 1860. So some researchers believe the 30 yr. old is Stephen Jr.

Some of our Texas Cousins believe Stephen Sr. had a daughter Sarah that never married, also there are stories of Uncle Jerry. Neither can be confirmed. (could be Jeremid, brother to Stephen of Ala. family)-

Stephen Nolan Jr. joined the Confederate Army. March 28, 1862 at Dallas, Texas. He returned to Harrison Co. and married Catherine E. Gillis Nov. 12, 1863. He was discharged from the army June 27, 1862. His age was recorded as 33 years.

In his narrative; History of Be-Twix the forks of the Cypress. Dr John Chad vividly describes conditions in the area of north Harrison Co. Tx. during and shortly after the Civil War. He mentions Stephen Nolan as operator of a lumber and grist mill on Cypress Creek.

Tradition tells us that Stephen Jr. was sorely grieved at the conditions existing in the area, he told his nephew at the end of the Civil War.

Jesse Jones that he was moving to California so off they went, never to be heard from again. It is thought that Stephen Sr. and others of the Nolan family went along, that is if there were others.

Elias Jones and Jenny remained in Texas, many Nieces, Nephews, grandsons and granddaughters still live around Harleton, Texas.

A reunion is held each year in May. The location Eagle Creek Cemetery.

David Nolan the eldest of two (r) Known sons of Stephen and his wife.

David born Oct. 12, 1824. died May 6, 1891.  
David born in ~~N.Y.~~ moved with his parents to Macon County Ala. by 1840.

Since Macon County was created from Indian lands in 1832, (Creek Indian Cession) it is presumed that Stephen Nolan and his family came to this area after 1832. They are recorded in Macon Co. 1840 U.S. Census. This is the earliest known recorded record of this family.

David Nolan married Catherine Cornelius Worthington-Wellington-Weatherington in Macon Co. Ala. Dec. 12, 1845. All three of the above spellings can be found in legal records. Wellington appears on the marriage license and is the only record of this spelling. Worthington can be found on marriage licenses of other members of the family. Cornelius had two brothers Joe and John in the Confederate Army both used Worthington on their Military Records also land deeds. Cornelius was the daughter of ~~S~~ Samuel Worthington and his wife Eliza "Betsy". After Betsy's death, Samuel married Mrs Eliza

(Sotoman ~~March~~<sup>May</sup> 28, 1868,) In Union Parish ba~~sed~~

Cornelia had (2) two sisters and (4) four brothers. (These are the only known ones)

David Nolan did not remain a widower very long. He married Catherine Andre Funderburk-Chunn, in July 1863.

Catherine Andre was the widow of James Chunn. James was killed in the Civil War and they had one son James Chunn Jr. Catherine was the daughter of Samuel Robt. Funderburk and Mary Ann Childress. Catherine was born March 8, 1846. She died April 26, 1884 and is buried in Antioch Cemetery.

David Nolan and Catherine Andre were the parents of (12) twelve children, nine (9) lived to reach adulthood.
