on ~~the~~ *Demand* one Year's Interest on the principal Sum of *Two pound & Eleven Shillings and five pence* and the like Interest annually

The said *James Oglisvie* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Two pound & Eleven Shillings and five Pence* on the *Eighteenth of July 1787* And the said *James Oglisvie* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the afore said ACT.
