Dear Ms. Gilmour:

I will try to give you the background on the Pannell/Dove research without getting too wordy.

Our client is a descendant of an Anderson Pannell of Fairfield, South Carolina. In the 1850 census, Anderson is listed as being 82 years old and born in Fairfield, SC. The client and some of his relatives have done some research and believe that Anderson is the son of William and Lucinda [Dove] Pannell. William and Lucinda had children William, Jr., Thomas, Benjamin, Anderson, Luke, Jonathan and Simeon. According to census information, William and Lucinda were born in Virginia. I was contacted to try and find the correct Pannell family in Virginia. I have researched a number of Pannell lines in various Virginia counties and have determined that the most likely is a Pannell family from Amherst County.

Other information passed on by the client is that a William Pannell had land grants in South Carolina in 1768, 1775 and 1786. There was also a William Pannell who served as a petit juror in 1778.
