

FAIRFIELD DISTRICT, SOUTH CAROLINA - DEED BOOK P - PAGE 222 - 11 MAY 1804: Deed to FRANCIS LONG and CHARLES PICKETT

ABGTRACTS OF WILLS & RECORDS (1796-1818) MONTSOMERY COUNTY, TENNESSEE - PUB. 1976 BY ANITA WHITEFIELD DARNELL:
Book A - Page 314 - 18 March 1808
Suit by Edward Byrd against John King in Hontgomery County, Tennessee! John King has died since the suit was
initiated and Charles Pickett is also deceased. Executors John and Moses King declined to act. Nathan King
Mississippi, only acting executor, appoints FRANCIS LONG of Montgomery County, Tennessee as his true Attorney.

Rook A - Page 315 - 19 Nov 1808

Power of Attorney from Selah Pickett, formerly of Fairfield District, South Carolina and now of Montgomery Co.

Tennessee, to son-in-law FRANCIS LONG "to collect what is owing me from my deceased husband, Charles Pickett."

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF CATAHOULA - DEED BOOK B. 8698 - PAGE 57 - NOV 1915 - RECORDED 14 DEC 1915: FRANCIS LONG of Catahoula Parish purchased land situated on Sicily Island (Hubbs laprovement) from Nathan King and wife Eliza (Knox) King: Hoses King and wife Elizabeth (Starke) King.

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF CATAHOULA - DEED BOOK B. FOLIO 232 - NO. 246-B - 28 AUS 1919: FRANCIS LONG of Catahoula Parish, State of Louisiana, gives Power of Attorney to Hilliam E. Parker of Parish and state aforesaid, to settle and arrange all manners of business between Jesse Havis, John Havis and Moses Knighton of the state of South Carolina re: Notes left in the hands of Jesse Havis & William Pickett by FRANCIS LONG and Charles Pickett. re: Notes given by FRANCIS LONG, Charles Pickett and Thomas Starke to the Executors of the estate of Jonathan Belton of South Carolina.

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF CATAHOULA - BOOK C. - PAGE 469 - 06 DEC 1823:
To the Honorable Sam Lightner, Parish Judge: I do certify that I am about to remove my domicile from the Parish aforesaid to the Parish of Concordia -- Siven under my hand this day and date written above. Sig: FRANCIS LONG

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF CONCORDIA - CONVEYANCE VOL. D. (1821-1825) - PAGE 293 - 26 DEC 1923: Deed from Edward P. King and wife Levisa King to FRANCIS LONG of same state and Parish aforesaid, Tract of land containing 300 acres, more or less, on banks of the Hississippi river about 16 miles below Natchez, granted to Basuel Norris and afterwards sold to Edward King - \$3,000 in hand paid at and before delivery. Bigned: E. P. King, Levisa King and FRANCIS LONG

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF CONCORDIA - CONVEYANCE VOL. E. (1825-1831) - 02 DEC 1825:
Know all men by these presents that we FRANCIS LONG and wife MARY K. LONG of Concordia Parish have bargained,
sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Ephraie Suice of same state & parish
aforesaid a certain tract of land containing 300 ac. lying on the banks of the Mississippi river about 16 miles
below the city of Natchez, granted to Samuel Morris & afterwards sold to Edward King, the same land we for and
in consideration of \$1500 to us in hand paid before delivery.

CHANCERY CLERK - MEADVILLE, FRANKLIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI:
The Franklin County Courthouse burned on 16 September 1876 destroying most of the deed books!however, the Index
to Land Deed transactions was saved. Among those burned were books B and C. References to deed gifts from book
D are from Hrs. Ethel B. Lewis, Chancery Clerk, in a letter to the Editor dated 19 Apr 1974. Copies of these
deeds are available.

In the column at the right are gift deeds which FRANCIS LONG made to his nine living children during the ten years before his death. Two days after his death on the 23rd of November 1942, these deeds were filed for probate. Another daughter, RHODA SAMANTHA, died 15 August 1832 at the age of seven years.
