## THE FAMILY OF WILLIAM ELLISON YONGUE AND AMANDA JANE PICKETT

AN ADDENDUM TO THE HISTORIES OF THE FAMILIES OF BOULWARE, ELLISON, MUSCOE, PICKETT, AND YONGUE

WILLIAM ELLISON YONGUE, son of William Alexander Yongue and Mary Ann Ellison, born 20 Sept. 1834, Fairfield Co., SC, married 15 Oct. 1860, Fairfield Co., SC to AMANDA JANE PICKETT, daughter of John B. Pickett and Sarah Boulware, born 3 Feb. 1838, Fairfield Co., SC. He enlisted 15 May 1862 at Columbia, SC, as a private in Company H, 2nd SC Cavalry and was honorably discharged at Chester, SC in 1865. They moved to Marion Co., FL in 1885 where she died 17 June 1913 and he died 27 Oct. 1919. They are buried at Millwood Cemetery, Reddick, Marion Co., FL. They had nine children:
