I might have that mixed up as he was the s/o Kissanah Pickett and her first husband Lazarus Pickett. The other three were the son's of Jephtha Boulware Pickett and Nancy Elizabeth Raines so that would make them cousins.

Four Doctors of the Pickett Family locate in Worth Co.

There were four doctors of the Pickett family who moved to Worth County from Webster Co.

Dr. Jesse Havis Pickett, the oldest of them and the half uncle of the other three, came in 1881 and settled in Ty Ty, GA. He lived there until his death in 1903. Ty Ty was not cut off into Tift County until after his death. So he was a citizen of Worth County all those years.

Jeptha B. (called Jack) Pickett was the next to come to Worth County. He located at Sumner in 1885. Sumner was the metropolis of Worth County at the time.

Dr. Reuben R. Pickett was the third in the order to come to Worth County. He came in 1892 and located at Sumner and was associated with his brother, Dr. Jack Pickett in the practice of medicine until the latter moved to Springfield, LA.

The last and youngest of these brothers was Dr. Frank Brown Pickett. He came in 1897 and located in Ty Ty, GA. He is the only one now living in this year of 1934.

The geneology of the Picketts show them to be descended from John Pickett, a Revolutionary Soldier mentioned in Archives of Historical Commission at Columbia, SC. Several of his grandsons moved from SC to Stewart, Webster and Sumter Counties, GA. This family of Picketts has given distinguished service in all American Wars. These doctors of Worth County are closely related to Major General George Edward Pickett, who made the famous charge at Gettysburg. They are descended from Edward Mobley and son, Samuel Mobley, of upper SC and Andrew Feaster, all of whom were Revolutionary soldiers.

Dr. Jesse Havis Pickett

Dr. Jesse Havis Pickett, the son of Jeptha and Jane Havis (McKiney) Pickett, was born April 12, 1828 in NC.

He came to Webster County and practiced medicine at Weston for a number of years. He enrolled as a volunteer in the Mexican War, June 15, 1847, at Lumpkin, GA and was mustered in Aug. 31, 1847 at Columbus, GA. He served as a private in Company B, Seymour's Battalion of GA and was promoted to corporal Dec. 15, 1847. He was mustered out July 10, 1848 at Mobile, AL, at the age of 19.

He volunteered to enter the Confederate Army and was elected Captain of Co. K, 17 GA Regt. of Infantry, Aug. 15, 1861 and was promoted to Major June 9, 1862 and resigned as Major on Jan. 5, 1864.

He was married in Webster County, Co., GA on Jan. 9, 1852 to Miss Lavinia M. Harper. He, with his family moved to Ty Ty, Worth County in 1881. He represented Worth County in the State Legislature two terms, 1886-1887, and was largely instrumental for getting local option for Worth County. He was public spirited and interested in progressive movements and ideas, and in his last years let these ideas influence him too far.

He practiced medicine all over this section at this section at a time when there were no good roads, few bridges, and poor pay. He was not a member of the Methodist Church but was one of the largest contributors to the building of the Ty Ty Methodist Church. In his last years he gave up his practice and accepted the Christian Science religion. He was a great admirer of Tom Watson. He was a devoted husband and father and a loyal friend.

He had three daughters: Sara married to John Payne, Shellman; Lillian married to Col. John Morrow of Tifton, GA; Cora married first to Hill and second to Pitt, of Ty Ty.

Jeptha Pickett, father of Dr. Jesse Havis Pickett, was born April 17, 1788. His mother Jane Havis (McKiney) Pickett was born Feb. 28, 1791.
