Yes, my line of Picketts moved to Webster Co. and there were a lot of them there until after the Civil war. The Thomas Hamilton Pickett moved to Dawson (next county), GA and three or four of them moved to Sumter County and Tift and Worth County.

I still remember Uncle Frank Pickett. He was a doctor and lived in TyTy, Tift Co. GA. He had his mother and father moved from the Pickett, Shippey cemetery in Webster Co and reburied in Tifton, Tift Co. That was Jepth Boulware Pickett and Nancy Elizabeth Raines. IIRC Uncle Frank was born about 1872 in Webster Co. and died in 1968. Uncle Frank was actually my grandmother's uncle. I still have some pictures of him.

My ggrandfather was William Raines Pickett, s/o Jeptha Boulware Pickett and Nancy Elizabeth Raines. He died in Randolph Co., GA in 1898. William Raines Pickett married Alice Hortense Bailey and they had one child, my grandmother, Annie Kate Pickett. William Raines Pickett died in April 1898 and Alice Bailey Pickett died in Mar. 1898, one month apart. My grandmother was born in Oct. 1897.
