Clarence Ernest Pickett b. 20 Nov. 1874; d. 26 Apr. 1940. Like some of his Pickett cousins, Clarence decided early in life that he wanted to be a doctor. His sister, Charlie, deserves much credit for his basid education and early training. He graduated from old Atlanta Medical College (Emory) in the class of 1894. After completing his medical training, he returned home and launched dual careers of medicine and farming. His practice included both medicine and surgery and spanned a period of forty years, interrupted only briefly during WWI. He received a commission in the U.S. Navy Medical Corps from 1 Oct. 1918 until 20 Mar. 1919; then reserve duty until 6 Sept. 1922 when he received his honorable discharge. He began his practice of medicine at a time when that profession, like many others was noted for hard work, long hours and poor pay. Through the years, he continued to study, to stay abreast of his contemporaries in the latest trends and application of medical technique.
