Basil Poole,

On 31 july 1781 at the age of 21 Charles Miles married Elizabeth Poole, a possible daughter of Basil Poole. who owned part of the tract of land called COWPASTURE.

Basil Poole had been born in Anne Arundel County about 1692 and died 1770. In 1788 Basil Poole, Jr. sold the land to John Holmesm Trustee. Later Basil Poole Jr purchaed Inad from Philemon Griffith; the

land bordered land of Charled Miles. In 1808 Basil Poole, Jr sold land to Richard Young. Basil m Lois Shipley, dau of Richard Shipley and Susanna Stevens. Richard in turn was the son of Adam Shipley and Lois Howard, possible daughter of Cornelius Howard. I am sure this took place in Montgomery County as Charles Miles lived in Clarksburg.

Jemima Thorne Mabry, born Jun or Dec 29, 1791 ?Jasper County Georgia? Married Jordan Thornton Oct. 31, 1811. Jordan Thornton son of Thomas Thornton and Mary Whatley, died Jan. 12, 1855 at Wetumpka, Alabama.

Family oral tradition - 1st Pool's in America.

If you are related to any of the following, we'd really appricate hearing any oral traditions about your founding families in America.

Families of James Pool (b 1756 VA), John Pool (b 1758 SC) abd Nicholas Pool (b 1765 GA) have a basically consistent oral tradition on the first POOL in thier line. If anyone in these lines or the Wm Mitchell Pool (b 1840 Arkansas), George Washington Pool (b 1814 Arkansas), Wm J Pool (b 182 TN), or Wm T Pool (b 1805 KY), PLEASE share your story.

here are the oral traditions from 3 related Pool families: (Y DNA haplogroup type G1 Pools)

John Pool (b 1758, SC) - 1st Pool(e) was "Adam Pool" who came from England (Ireland?) with 3 sons in the early 1700's, settling initially in New England.

Nicholas Pool (b 1765 GA) 3 brothers came to America.

James B Pool (b 1756 VA) -our line is of Scotts -Irish descent.

I am from the William Thomas Pool b 1805 Kentucky. He married Delilah Brown b 1807 Kentucky. I can't seem to find his parents. Would love any help I can get.

The short answer is I don't know who the parents of this Wm Pool were .

I do, however, know 6 other lines of Pool that have tested nearly identical to this Wm T Pool.

Gary Pool, who died in 2008 was of this line and I have his work. There are also living descendants of this Wm T Pool who are getting DNA tests now -- with results due in February -- so we may know a lot more at the end of February.

Your line and my line should -- according to the statistics - connect within 4 to 6 generations. I currently have solid information on 5 generations and tentative information on my 6th generation which I'd be happy to share.

It is possible that you are descended from my James B Pool (born in VA in 1756, fought in Rev War, moved to SC and became a sucessful cotton farmer). If not, you should be no further distant than a direct descendant of James Pool's 2nd cousin.

Based on my personal experience, I highly recommend checking out which "blood line" of Pool's you belong to. If any male Pool in your family has been tested, we can use those results to determine which line you belong with. (maybe I should have said "DNA" lines since the typical test just involves brushing a little skin from the inside of your cheek).

There are a number of us who have gone back in America as far a we can (in my case,Alexander Pool, b about 1730 in Virginia), and now really need to tie to our Pool cousins in England. So if you can determine which is your Pool blood line, there are PLENTY of us here that would be eager to share data with you.

I can tell you some things about the Pool(e)'s in America. Depending on which surnames you count there are something between 17 and 22+ distinct (un-related) blood lines of Pool / Poole / Pettypool / Pooley (there are also Puhl's, etc which I did not count).

By far the most common are Y haplogroup R1b1 amd R1b2 lines -- there are about 15 distinct lines of this Y haplogroup.

There are 5 lines that are 11 or 12 variants. Then there are a few scattered "odd ball lines" like J1 and G1. My line happens to be G1. In England, only 1 to 2% of the population is Y haplogroup G -- and (my guess) that the relatively rare G1a that my group of Pool's belong to represents less 1 person in 10,000 in England or America (If you turn out to be G1 like me, there is a lot of interesting information and speculations about how G1 people came to be in England).

If any male in your Pool line has had a DNA test, you can tell you exactly which line of Pool you tie to (here, the tests start at only about \$ 100 for a basic test from National Geographic's "Genographic" project)-- you can compare it yourself by entering the data (you can keep you identity confidential if you wish) for free at YSEARCH.ORG (I can "talk you through entering this data if you find it confusing).

I hope this information is of help ... if you have additional questions ,just let me know and I'll try to answer them. There are also good articles on Wikipedia, etc that describe how genetic testing is being used these days in genealogy.

In my case, the only reason that the 7 closely related lines of "haplo G1" Pool's know each other (and we are working closely together to figure out our common lineage) is through DNA testing. Before we had test results, we mistakenly thought we tied into a Pettypool line, but once we got the DNA results, we knew that we were a true "Pool" line.

are you a close relative of Gary Pool who died of cancer in 1998 or so?

If so, a close relative of Gary's is getting additional DNA tests, results due in February. This might well prove if there is (as I suspect, but cannot prove right now) that William T Pool of KY was a direct descendant of James B Pool (born 1756 in Brunswick VA) or a brother to this James Pool (Sr.).

Gary Grandfather, Napolian Bonaparte Poole, was the brother to my Great-Great Grandmother, Martha Malinda Poole (Pickett).

The Dorsey Family by Dorsey, Dorsey and Nimmo page 83 lists a Michael Poole m. Elizabeth Poole September 6, 1796, Frederick County. Michael was the son of John and Ann Dorsey. Ann b. Oct. 2,1740

was the daughter of Philemon and Katherine Dorsey. John b. July 3, 1734; d. 1779 Anne Arundel County (his will is in this same book) was the son of Michael Dorsey and Ruth Todd.

I am looking for the children of a Michael Dorsey, wife unknown. Do you have the children of Michael Dorsey and Elizabeth Poole? I believe my GGGrandfather, James W. Dorsey's father was a Michael Dorsey but I have been unable to make any connection. Any information you have concerning Michael and Elizabeth Poole Dorsey would be extremely helpful.
