On this 20th day of May 1846- personally appeared before the undersigned, Judge of the County Court of the State and County aforesaid Mary Pope a resident of the County of Clallie in the State of Alabama aged about ninety seven years who being first duly sworn according to law doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 4th 1836- and the act explanatory of said act passed March 3. 1837 that she was married to Isaac Ricks Pope who entered the service of the United States as a private in the State of South Carolina Fairfield District under Captain Richard Wier under the command of Genl Williamson the time of the entrance into the service of the United States by ~~Isaac my~~ husband
