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(p.736) 17 Apr 1727.... William Jones of Brunswick County to John Jones of Surry County.... 1 acre on north side of Sappony Creek in Surry County (being the 1 acre William Jones' mill stands on).

(p.738) 18 Apr 1727.... William Jones of Brunswick County to Richard Huson of Surry County.... 400 acres on north side of Nottoway River and both sides of Sappony Creek and bounded by Robert Jones, the county line with Prince George County and the Rocky Branch (being the land granted William Jones on 17 Aug 1725).

(p.741) 19 Jul 1727.... William Seward, Roger Delk and John (X) Bruce value the slave named John Banks who lately belonged to Bartlett Morland, decd.

(p.742) 16 Aug 1726.... William Mellon to John Wilburn.... 100 acres on north side of Three Creeks (being the 100 acres granted to William Mellon on 23 Feb 1724).

(p.753) 20 Sep 1727.... William Cook of Southwarke Parish and wife, Rebecca Cook, to William Briggs of the same for Love and Affection for their sons James Cook and Reuben Cook.... 200 acres in Southwarke Parish which was devised to the said Rebecca Cook by the will of her father, James Jones, decd., dated 6 Apr 1719.

(p.754) 24 Jul 1727.... Charles Kimball, carpenter of Southwarke Parish, to William Moore of the same.... 235 acres on south side of Nottoway River and bounded by Richard Moore and Thomas Dean (being the tract granted to said Charles Kimball on 27 Feb 1724).

(p.759) 29 Jul 1727.... William Rainey to Francis Lightfoot.... 100 acres on south side of main Blackwater Swamp.

(p.762) 17 Apr 1727.... James Judkins to William Rainey.... 275 acres on north side of the little creek of Three Creeks (being the land granted to said James Judkins on 22 Feb 1724) and bounded by Thomas Jackson. (Helen Judkins, wife of James Judkins, relinquished her Right of Dower.)

(p.765) 8 Oct 1727.... Charles Briggs to John Smith.... 115 acres on south side of main Blackwater Swamp in Lawnes Creek Parish and bounded by said Smith and said Briggs (being 1/2 of a patent granted said Charles Briggs for 230 acres).

(p.766) 22 Jul 1724.... William Dickins to Alexander Dickins.... 100 acres on south side of Nottoway River in Southwarke Parish (being part of a tract of 400 acres granted to Robert Hawthorne on 24 Oct 1701 who sold it to Thomas Dickins, decd., father of William Dickins who left it to his son).

(p.254) 15 Aug 1711.... John Allen petitions to complete the building of a Water Mill lately begun by his deceased father, Maj. Arthur Allen, in the branches of lower Chipokes Creek. Robert Ruffin and William Chambers are to value the land.

(p.255) 16 Jan 1732.... George Norwood of Bartie Precint in North Carolina to Benjamin Chapman Donaldson of Surry County.... 80 (85 ?) acres adjoining Thomas Jordan.

(p.258) 20 Jan 1732.... William Glover of Surry County to Benjamin Harrison, Gent., of Charles City County.... 100 (150?) acres in Southwarke Parish (being the land formerly granted Nathaniel Dennis on 20 Oct 1689 and by him sold to William Dennis on 6 Mar 1693). Land adjoins Mr. Benjamin Harrison and William Lucas.

(p.260) 20 Mar 1732.... Peter Bagly and wife, Mary Bagly, to William Shands.... 100 acres on south side of main Blackwater Swamp and bounded by Collens Branch and Pidgeon Swamp.

(p.265) 9 Jan 1732.... Richard Powell and wife, Mary Powell, and Anne Warren to William Gray, Jr.... 300 acres bounded by Indian Spring Branch and Thomas King.

(p.269) Bond of Mathew Parham and William Browne for Mathew Parham as Guardian to Cuthbert Williamson, Orphan.

(p.271) 17 Apr 1732.... John Pasmore and wife, Sarah Pasmore, to Nicholas Harpor.... 100 acres on south side of Nottoway River and bounded by said Pasmore and Island Swamp.

(p.275) 22 Mar 1732.... Robert Poythres of Prince George County to John Parrum.... 267 acres on south side of main Blackwater Swamp and bounded by Indian Swamp and Beaver Pond Swamp.

(p.279) 22 Oct 1732.... William Marriott to William Gray, Jr.... 135 acres bounded by Capt. William Browne's Mill, Ware Neck Mill Swamp and Grays Creek.
