To: William Sewell, Hugh Est, John West for quitrents of 1594 a. for years 1755-1759, Charles Broadwater for levies, James Garvey, John Doues, Willoughby Newton, Daniel French, William Green, John Hough for quitrents for 1760-63, John West for levies and poll tax for yrs. 1757 & 1758, James Lane for land and poll tax for 1757, Thomas Beach for judt., Henry Wishart his ballance due from Christopher Neale, George Johnston, John Minor sheriff of Loudoun for land tax in 1760 and for 3 co. and parish levies, Leven Powell for land levies and Poll tax, John Minor sheriff of Loudoun land tax, John Moss sheriff of Loudoun for 10 levies and taxes, Kincheloe, George Candever for smiths work, Elijah Wickliff, Jacob Ramey for two Tob. houses erected on estate, Benjamin Rush for smiths work, Robert Boggess for parish levies, Thomas Triplett for Co. levies, Edward Payne for smiths work, to smiths work done for the estate of Henry Mozeen, Carlyle and Dalton, Charles Broadwater for levies, Thomas Triplett for poll tax, Wm. West sheriff of Loudoun for yr. 1761, land and poll tax.

On May 21, 1764 came Mrs. Ann More formerly Ann Neale the Adm. of Christopher Neale late of Fairfax dec. made oath that the above accts. is justly and truly stated.

To: 1764: Amot. of debts pd. by my wife, cloathing and tools for negros about 20 in number since death of Christ. Neale in July or Aug. 1756 (the accot. being burnt is left to the court), Wm. Talbutt for Tob., John Moss for land tax on 1588 a. and Co. levies and poll tax, Christ. Parfait for 10 parish levies, rents pd. Col. Fitzhugh in 1757-61. to William Talbotts share of crop in 1757, 1758, 1760, 1761, Jacob Rameys share in 1763, Gerard Bowling for picking and Prizing Tob., shares of two negros belonging to Miss Osborn in 1757 viz: Prince and Peg, to Wm. Spencer in part of his legacy, Benjamin Sebastian ads. West, legacy left me by will.

To: Wm. Vandevers share of crop 1762, waggonage tob. for Frederick in 1762, tob. to Occoquan 1761-1764, Jacob Ramey's share of tob., Mr. Wm. Ellzey, cost of Beaches suit.

1757 By: Tob. Occoquan, Pohick, Hunting Cr., by 3 rents, tob. sold in Frederick Co., John West Jr., and Robert Adam Gent. have examined acc'ts. of Henry More and Ann his wife. Dated Nov. 20, 1764.
