Also, I have attached the Price Burying Ground records from the Chester County Tombstone book.

Attached is the only land/deed transaction records I can find in Fairfield County for William Price.

First when he acquired the land from Richard Winn and then over to Dorcas Mobley's father.

The Mobley's lived in this area of Fairfield and Chester counties.

No other deed/land records, plats, probate or wills for Price's could be found in Fairfield County.

Checking online at Ancestry, etc. and your tree, I can offer no additional records except what has been attached.





Subject: ancestor search

Mr. Killian,

Eric Robinson at the Fairfield County Library suggested I contact you. I have been searching for some information about the parents of an ancestor of mine, Jane Catherine Price, who was born in Winnsboro, SC on September 25, 1828, according to family records. She died in Cortland, NY March 20, 1879.

Jane Catherine, was the wife of Clark Wheeler Upson, and married in Macon, GA June 28, 1848. She was the daughter of Catherine Drennan Ritchey Price, as recorded in <u>The Upson Family In America</u> genealogy. Her father was Thomas Sumpter Price. Thomas and Catherine were married in South Carolina on January 10, 1822, according to family records. Family records in Ancestry.com show that Thomas was born in Lexington, SC around 1796/7.

(1797-1860) 5 PRICE - DRENNAN RITCHEY (1790-1860)

There are family trees that claim Thomas and Catherine had more children than Jane and another daughter, Harriett's, married name was Griffin. In their (Griffin) family's census records, her mother, Catherine Price, was born in Ireland. There are many connections between the names, Upson and Griffin. In the 1850 census for Clark Wheeler and Jane Upson, they housed an apprentice to Clark's carriage making who was named J.R. Griffin. Clark's son was named Albert Griffin Upson and Joel and Harriett Griffin named a daughter Alice Upson Griffin. I am challenged by this information without proof. Were Thomas and Catherine parents of other children? Was Catherine born in Ireland?

I would like to know where to look for the information I need without having to become famous and be sent around by "Who Do You Think You Are?" If you can point me to any place this information is accessible, I would appreciate your help.
