Died 10 Sep 1847 at Puebla, transferred to Co. C,
Sterling on card & SH, from Georgia.
- Pulaski, Fredrick. Pvt, Co. K
Survived.
- Pulliam, Benjamin S. Pvt, Co. E 278
Discharged 27 Oct 1847 at Puebla for disability, middle
initial L. on SH.
- Purse, Wm F. Corpl, Co. H
Survived, 2nd Cpl, Pvt on card.
- Purvis - see also Parvis
- Purvis, Stephen. Pvt, Co. F
Died Jun 1847 at Perote.
- Qualls, Wm. Pvt, Co. L
Survived, CHRL notes "recruited at Notasulga."
- Quick, Daniel. Pvt, Co. H
Survived.
- *Quinn, James F. Corpl, Co. F
Discharged 27 Oct 1847 at Mexico City [by substitute],
4th Cpl, City of Charleston medal exists.
- *Rabb, Eber A. Sergt, Co. G
Discharged 5 May 1847 at Jalapa for disability, 1st Cpl
on card, SH, PRB & CHRL.
- Rains, Jason. Pvt, Co. G
Discharged 18 Jan 1848 at Puebla for disability, Raines
on card & SH.
- Ramsay, John J. Pvt, Co. A 24
Survived, John James Ramsey on card & letter from his
father from Manchester, SC, probably died after return.
- Ramsey, E. W. Pvt, Co. D 239
Died 10 Feb 1847 at sea, Edward W. Ramsay on card.
- Randolph, Edward G. Corpl, Co. H
Survived, 1st Cpl, Pvt on card & SH.
- Rasse - see Rape
- Rape, Ivy. Pvt, Co. C 309
Died 15 June 1847 at Puebla, Rasse on card & SH.
- Rast, Patrick. Pvt, Co. H 225
Died May 1847 at Vera Cruz.
