

RABB CEMETERY - At the Triangle south of Winnsboro, SC where highways 321 and 213 meet, take 213 towards Jenkinsville and drive 7.4 miles. On the left a short distance in the woods is the cemetery. It is surrounded by a metal fence. If you come to a white house on the left with Sanders on the mailbox, you have gone too far. You have to cross a small ditch and crawl up an embankment. I have visited this place 3 times - first in 1975, 1978 and 1983.

- 1. A Trioute of affection to a beloved father Mr. Thomas A Rabb born in 1792 died Apr. 10th 1840
- 2. A Tribute of affection to a beloved mother Mrs. Massey P. Rabb born Apr. 28th 1792 died 20 June 1852
- 3. Eber (piece of stone missing) born 8th Jany 1823 died 12th Oct. 1864

- 4. Martha C. Rabb born Sept. 2nd 1823 died May 29, 1895
- 5. Eber A. Rabb born Nov. 25th 1855 died Sept. 20, 1895

The little flat stones 6, 7, & 8 had no inscriptions on them. They are thought to be infant children of Eber (#3) and Martha C. Rabb (#4).

The wife of Eber A. Rabb (Jr.) Theodora Klinck Rabb, and his brother William Robertson Rabb are buried in the Episcopal Cemetery - Winnsboro, SC along with succeeding generations.
