RABB FAMILY CEMETERY

Recorded: 13 March 1974

Located off of Highway 31, about the miles from Evergreen, at the community of Rabb, Alabama. This cemetery is surrounded by a brick wall with an iron gate. It is on part of the original tract of land purchased by William Rabb in 1819. Nearby is the community of Old Town. Rabb is also known as Rabbville and Rabb's Store.
