will names son-in-law JOHN FREE, and he wondered  
if Mary Glazier was his wife; however, Elizabeth  
E. Glazier was the wife of Arthur Yarborough in  
the Glazier Bible, but she had died before the will  
was made and Yarborough may have died and  
she may have married John Free. Also, Robert Rabb  
is named as son-in-law in the will and he may  
have been husband of Mary Glazier.
