ELIZABETH HABB

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN-----

I Elizabeth Habb altho' ~~some~~ bodily afflictions, yet being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and wishing to regard the kind admonitions of a blessed Saviour Jesus Christ, both as regards my temporal and eternal affairs " Be ye ready for in such an hour as ye think not the summons cometh" In order therefore to make a Suitable disposition of the worldly estate, which God has blessed me with, do make & ordain this my last will in manner following, that is to say :

I desire all my Slaves as soon as convenient to be sold upon a credit of twelve months with interest from the date, with two Sufficient Securities- My stock of cattle hogs &c to remain in the hands of my Son Alexander for the support of the family and Subject to his disposal altho', and that the crop which may be in hands or on hands at the time of my death, I desire like wise to be at the entire disposal of my Son Alexander, for the support of the family and his own interest- paying my funeral expences out of the Same or if any Doctors bill the same is to be thus paid out of the crop- That out of the money arising from the Sales of my Slaves- One hundred Dollars shall be divided into five equal parts. Say twenty Dollars, to each of my children John- William Charles- Elizabeth Bell & Mary Ann Crompton, and that the whole amount of balance of Sales, shall be equally divided with my Son Robert my Daughters, Nancy & Sarah That I further desire and do will and bequeath to my Son Alexander all my landed estate and that in consideration of his advantages in the same he is to pay twenty Dollars also to each of my five children, William, John Charles Margus & Elizabeth. And all the estate as may increase from hence previous to my death shall be equally divided with my children Robert Nancy & Sarah- And I do hereby give the same as above disposed to them. their Heirs &c
