JAMES RUSSELL

In the Name of God Amen

I James Russel of fair field District and state of south carolina being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory calling to mind the mortallity of the body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make constitute and appoint this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say first of all I give my Body to the earth from whence it was taken nothing doubting but I shall receive the same again through the mighty power of god

A and as touching such worldly estate estate as it has pleased god to blesse me with in this life I give and bequeath the same in the following manner

Item it is my will that all my just debts be paid Item I give to my beloved daughter Mary Wate one shilling. I give to my beloved daughter Rachel Nobly one shilling I give to my son William one hundred acres of land ^{apart} being of a tract of land granted william barnet adjoining to james russells land north of the said land starting on ^{only if and when} the east line and continuing to the west line I give to william the sum of one pound to the family of my beloved daughter Mary Hutchinson one shilling I give to my beloved son James one shilling I do give to my beloved wife all the rest of my land after William has his surveyed of and all personally property and to be at her disposal if die without disposing of the land and stock the hole be sold and equally divided between my son John and my daughter giny and my son robert and my barnet only I reserve and do give to nancy myth one bed and furniture I do make constitute and appoint my beloved wife my sole executor to this my last will and testament in witness I have here unto set my hand and seal this 13 of June 1806
