Item I give to my beloved daughter Mary Wate one shilling- I give to my beloved daughter Rachel Mobly one shilling I give to my son William one hundred acres of land being of atrack of land granted william barnet adjoining to James russels land north of the said land starting on the east line and continuing to the west line ^{only if sold by} I give to my beloved daughter barbery Hutchinson one shilling I give to my beloved son James one shilling I do give to my beloved wife all the rest of my land after William has his surveyed of and all personally property and to be at her disposal if die without disposing of the land and stock the hole be sold and equally divided between my son John and my daughter giny and my son robert and my barnet only I reserve and do give to nancy sayth one bed and furniture I do make constitute and spoint my be loved wife my sole executor to this my last will and testament in witnife I have here unto set my hand and seal this 18 of June 1806
