

Thomas Cason Raines. Born Sept. 24, 1841, eight miles East of Winnsboro. Entered Army March, 1862 in Boyce's Guards, under Capt. J. M. Phinney. Was wounded at



the Battle of Wilderness May 6,

1863. Now farming.
"I would not receive a promotion, had it been offered as I felt that I could serve my country better with a rifle than a sword." Private

Company G, 6th South Carolina Infantry

Enlisted; Winnsboro, March 17, 1862

Wounded; Near Richmond, May 6, 1864

Paroled; Appomattox, April 9, 1865

On last roll; January/February, 1865.
