



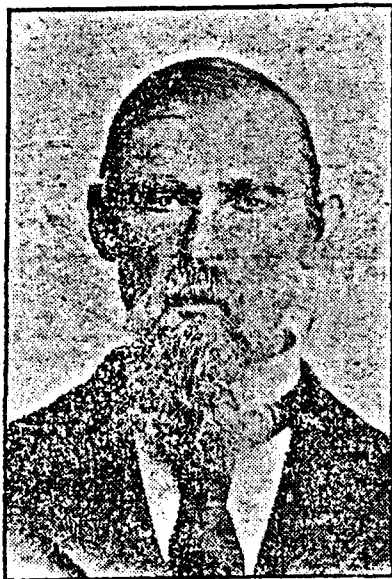

tered Army March, 1862 in
Boyce's Guards, under Capt. J.
M. Phinney. Was wounded at



the Battle of Wilderness May 6,
1863. Now farming.

tion, had it been offered as I felt
that I could serve my country
better with a rifle than a
sword."
