

# JAMES H. RION DIES

Winnsboro, Jan. 18.—News has been received here of the sudden death of James H. Rion, at his home in Tryon, N. C., Tuesday night, following only two hours of illness. The news came as a great shock and sorrow to relatives of Mr. Rion in Winnsboro and to his friends here.
