I, GEORGE H. RION, of the Town of Winnsboro, in the County of Fairfield and State of South Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, but mindful of the uncertainty of life, do hereby make, publish and declare this the following as and for my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills by me heretofore made.

ITEM 1. My household goods have, for some years, been in the custody of my sister, Addie R. Dixon of Greenville, South Carolina. At my death she shall continue such control and possession for her use and benefit during her natural life and, at her death, such belongings shall become the sole property of my brother, Sam W. Rion, now residing at Georgetown, South Carolina.

ITEM 2. All of the rest, residue and remainder of my property of whatsoever nature or kind, I give, bequeath and devise to my said sister, Addie R. Dixon, my said brother, Sam W. Rion, and my other brother, Ed W. Rion, share and share alike, provided, however, the cash portion of my estate vesting in my brother Ed under this bequest shall be held by my said sister, Addie R. Dixon, as trustee and, as such, she shall pay over to my said brother Ed, commencing as soon as practicable after my death, the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per month until the entire principal has been exhausted. If, however, my said brother shall die before said fund is exhausted, then the remaining corpus or principal shall vest in my said sister Addie and my said brother Sam, share and share alike.

ITEM 3. My said trustee shall not be required to give any bond for acting as such and she shall exercise her sound discretion as to the manner of depositing said fund or investment thereof.

ITEM 4. I hereby nominate and appoint my said sister, Addie R. Dixon, as the Executrix of this my will and she shall not be required to give any bond for qualifying or acting as such.
