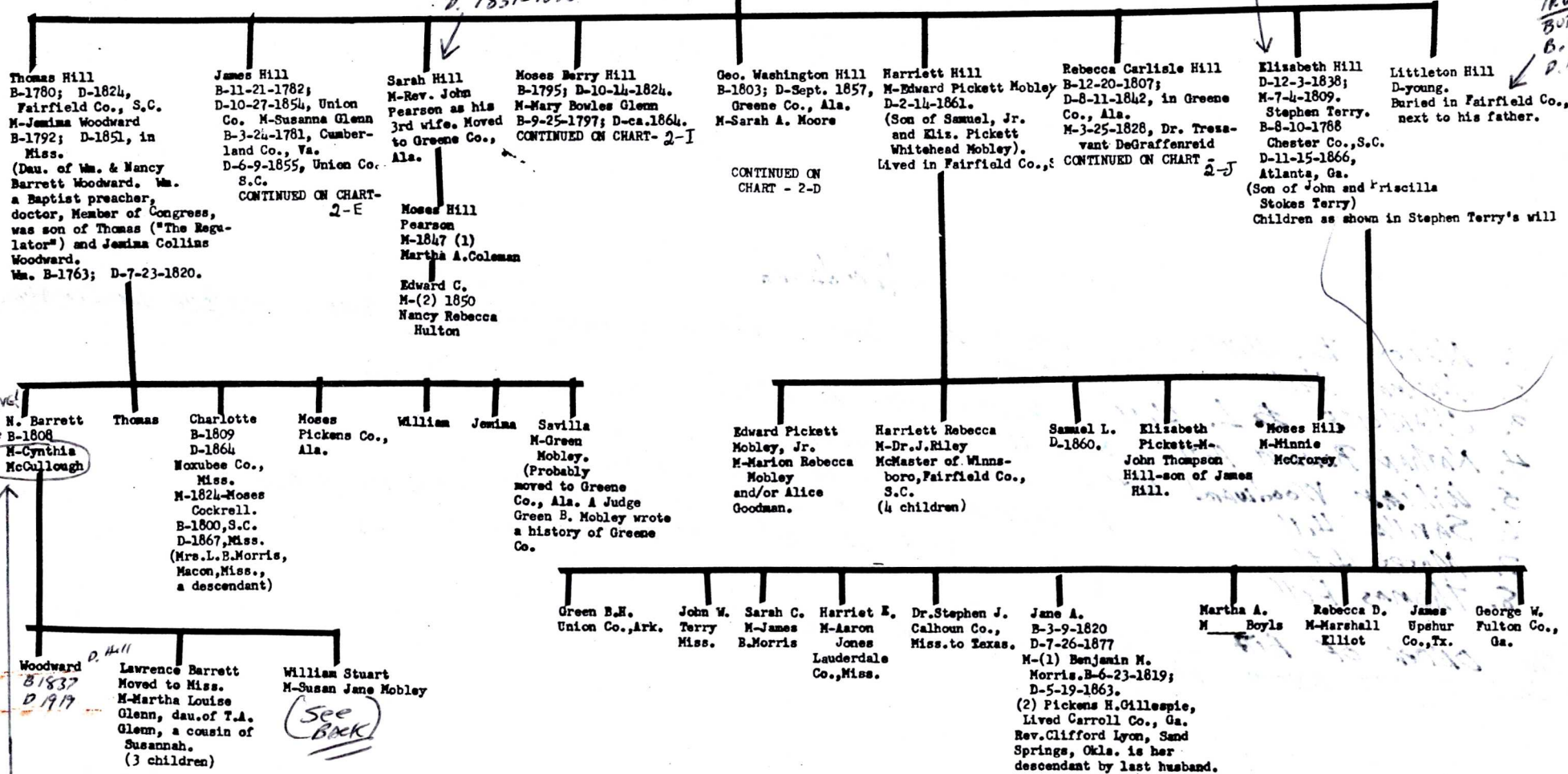
1/ Moses Hill was a Rev. soldier in the S.C. Militia. His Rev. service is the first record that has been found. He served in the forces of Col. Winn of Fairfield Co., and lived in N.W. Fairfield Co., for the rest of his life. He was a large landowner, a Justice of the Peace, a surveyor, and was evidently very well educated. He wrote a beautiful hand. His old home was still standing in the 1930's, but has since been torn down. His widow, Savilla, moved to Greene Co., Ala., ca. 1831, with her son George W. and dau. Rebecca DeGraffenreid.

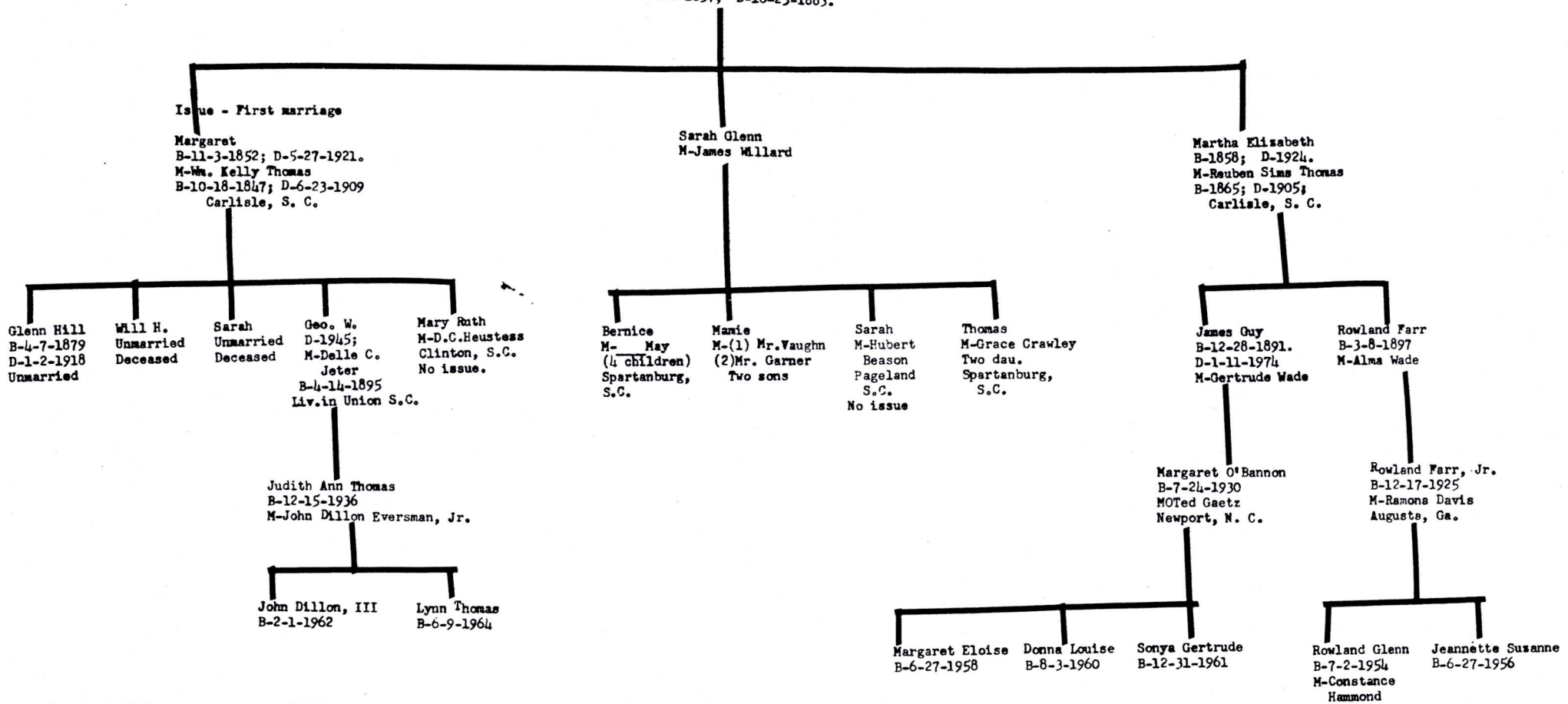


1/ James Hill farmed extensively and at his death he owned 7500 acres of land and 35 slaves named in his will. Land and slaves were divided among his heirs. He build in the 1820's "Hillside", a large two story white house near Carlisle, now owned by his g-granddaughter, Jeannette Christopher. His wife, Susannah Glenn, was the dau. of James and Elisabeth Bowles Glenn, who moved from Hanover Co., Va., to Cumberland Co., Va., thence to Chester Co., S. C., immediately after the Rev. James Glenn was a Lt. in the Va. Militia during the Rev., the son of James Glenn who died in Hanover Co., in 1763 and was in parish records in 1717.

His 2nd wife, Sarah Graham, was the dau. of Emory and Teresa Eusebia (Richards) Graham of York Co., S. C., and Mecklenburg Co., S.C. Sarah Graham was a graduate of Greensboro Female College, Greensboro, N. C. Her family, both sides, were originally from Penn. and New Hampshire.

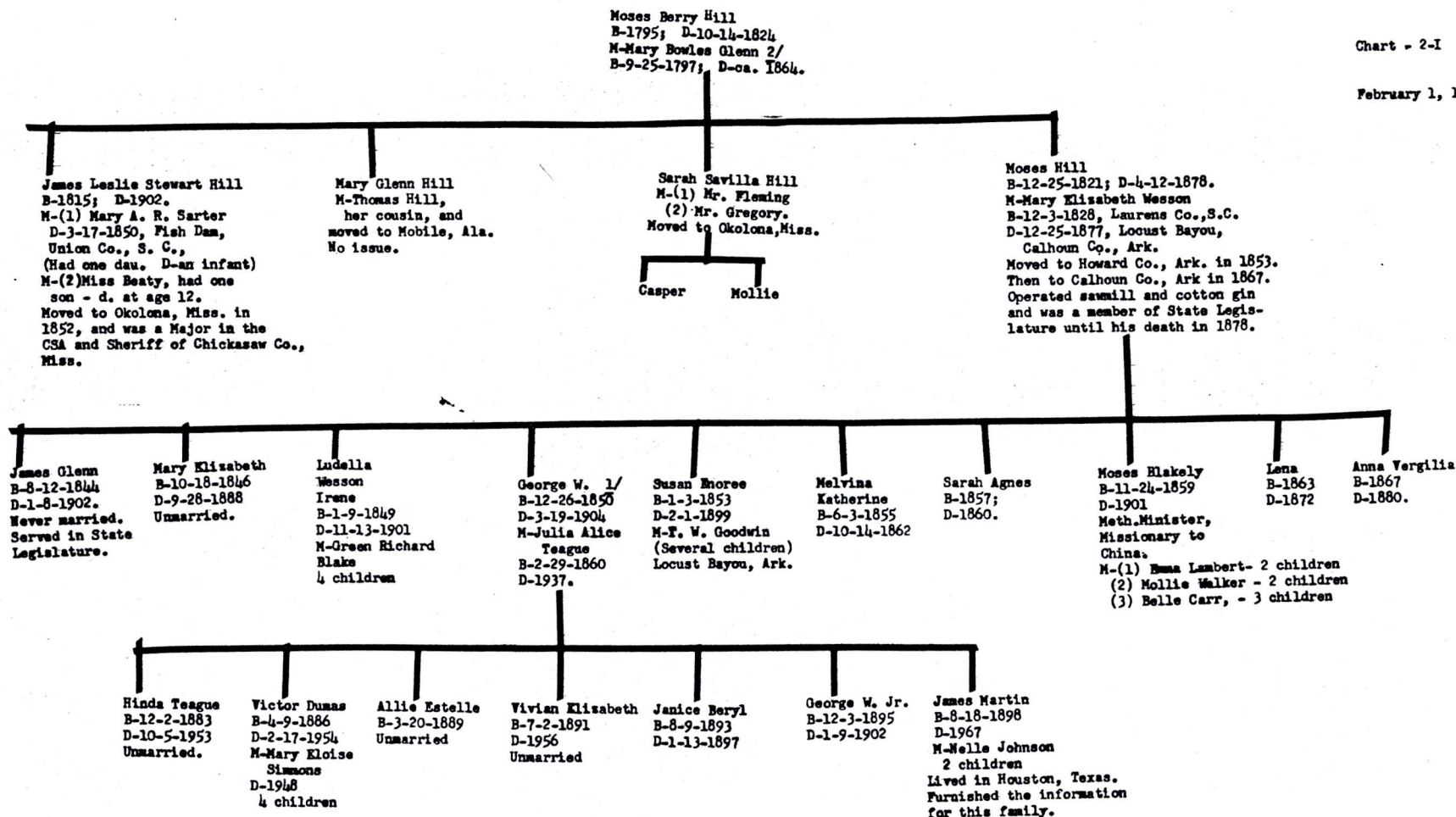

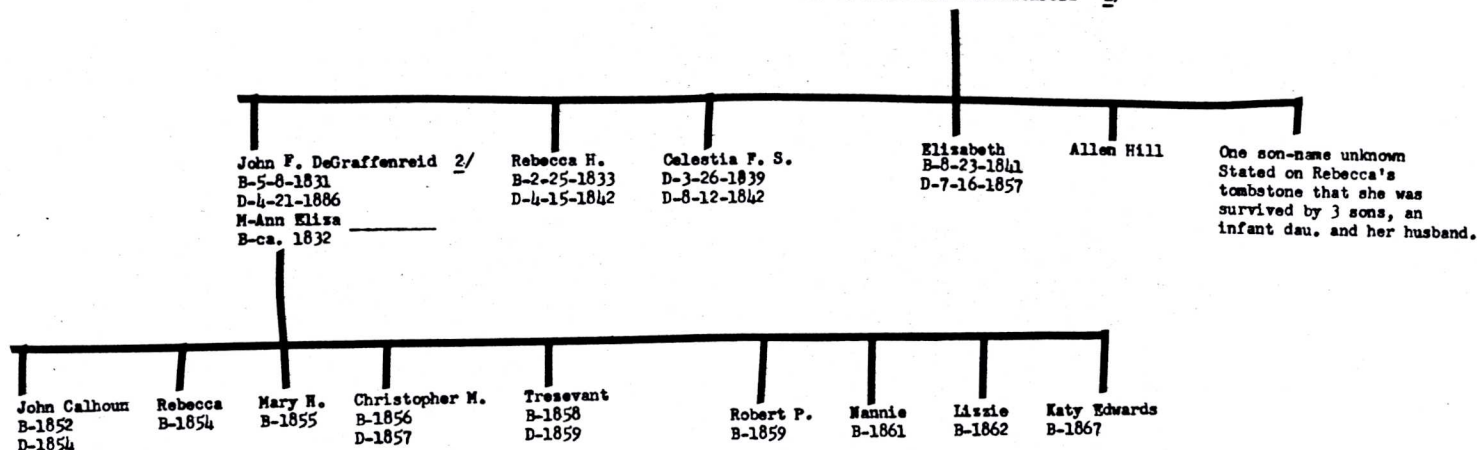

2/ The names of these children and grandchildren were derived from tombstones and census records. In 1965 I visited the "Old" Williams Cemetery in Greene Co., Ala., where Savilla Roden Hill and her children and grandchildren are buried, and talked to Miss Mary Marshall, a county historian, who lived near the cemetery. Miss Marshall said that others of the family were buried in Pleasant Hill Cemetery. Dr. DeGraffenreid put very complete records of his wife and children on their tombstones, including the cause of death - "bilious fever", etc. Descendants of this family still live in Tuscaloosa, Ala., about 20 miles from the cemetery. There is a DeGraffenreid Law firm in Tuscaloosa, and a history of the DeGraffenreid family in the Univ. of Ala. library, but it does not give any information about Rebecca's family, except that she was a Hill. The old cemetery is on private property and was in bad shape in 1965, but you could see the stones. I visited it again in the summer of 1974, and it was so overgrown I had to crawl around on my hands and knees to even find Savilla's stone again, and hers is the first one in the cemetery. A man at a nearby filling station said that the people who owned the property lived out of the state and took no interest in the cemetery. In 1965, a gentleman at the Greene Co. Courthouse in Eutaw, Ala., said that all of the Hill family had moved from the county. Moses Hill Pearson, son of John and Sarah Hill Pearson, is also buried in the cemetery. According to Mrs. F. P. Jones of Houston, Texas, John and Sarah Pearson are buried there, too, but I did not see their graves; however, I was not looking for them and, with the undergrowth, I could have missed them. Mrs. Jones is a descendant of John Pearson by one of his other wives. The DeGraffenreids are descendants of the DeGraffenreid family who settled Newbern, N. C.

1/ Dr. J. Tresevant DeGraffenreid was the son of Christopher DeGraffenreid of Fairfield or Chester Co., S. C., and Christopher DeGraffenreid was the son of Charner DeGraffenreid, Sr., of Lunenburg Co., Va. POA recorded in Deed Book (HH-a), pgs. 194 and 195, 1830, Fairfield Co., S. C., from Christopher DeG. to his son Tresevant DeG. to handle Christopher's share of his father Charner's estate.
