It is surrounded by a cast iron fence, is about 45 feet on each side, and contains four rows of graves. There seem to be about 30 graves recognizable, with several being unmarked.

- A) Grave #10, Sally Elkin, is the second wife of William B. Elkin. She was the daughter of John Nicholas and Elizabeth Entzminger Bookhardt of Orangeburgh District.
- B) The case William B. Elkin et al vs. John Simonton et al, Richland District Court of Equity, Bill # 547 (SCDAH) involves the division of lands belonging to the estate of John Ross, late of Fairfield District. In the course of the case, a list of decendants is drawn up in order to determine shares. Several of the people listed are buried in the Ruff Cemetery.
