Thanks for talking with me today. Here is info you requested. Hoping you are able to find out **Charlotte's maiden name**, her **husband's name**, and possibly **what happened to her farm after she willed it to her two sons**.

WILL HAVE TO GO TO COURT HOUSE

Charlotte Smith B: 10 or 19 Feb 1787 in SC D: 28 Dec 1860, Fairfield, SC- burial Bethel United Methodist, Winnsboro, SC, Obi - Southern Christian Advocate

(Bethel ME church)

Records of her found in:

- *1850 Fed Census
- *SC Wills & Probate Records 1670-1980
- *US, Selected Federal Census Non-Population Schedules, 1850-1880

Known Children:

Thomas C. Smith 1816-? Lived after death of brother George on home place with George's widow, children, other relatives as per later census. Death: unknown - Burial in Bethel United Meth., Winnsboro but no death date perhaps no marker.

NO TOMBSTONE

George D. Smith - B: 18 Jan 1818, found a record indicating his birth was in Richland County D. 6 Apr 1868, buried in Bethel United Meth. Cem., Winnsboro beside infant son.
Married Mary A. Hinnant 1839-1880

Children: Thomas F. Smith 1859-1916
George William Smith 1862-1920
Margaret C. Smith Robinson 1863-1889
One year old infant son ----? Kennedy Smith

Interesting that George D. Smith MIGHT have been born in Richland County. Perhaps his father was from there. Making it difficult is family names of Thomas and George as names of two brothers are repeated in two generations.

I do hope you will have some success in solving this old mystery.
