For another gift in another world.*



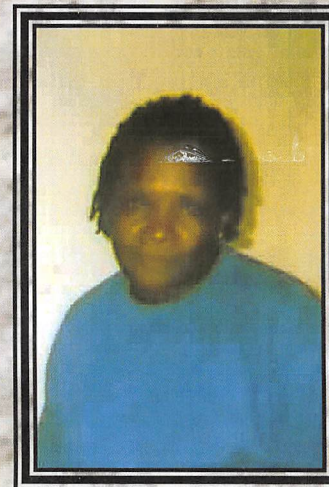
