I need documentary proof of revolutionary service, wills, births, deaths, and marriages on Edward (Moberly) Mobley, Sr., Edward (Moberly) Mobley, Jr., William Burford, and James Rabb. My line from Edward (Moberly) Mobley, and Susanna DuRual is as follows:

I sent in a supplemental application on Edward Mobley, Sr. to DAR using a short form. My information came from my father's cousin who went in on Edward Mobley, Sr. The supplemental was returned stating that the line was closed in 1976 when it



was proven Edward Mobley, Sr. died in 1765, ten years before the Revolutionary War. I found in Roster of South Carolina Patriots by Bobby Gilmer Moss where Edward Mobley, Sr. served in 1781-1782, and Edward Mobley, Jr. served in 1781. I feel that after the death of Edward, Sr. in 1765, Edward, Jr. became Sr. and Edward III became Jr. The same book names William Buford as a patriot in the American Revolution. My family spells the name Burford. I have a copy of his will.

Thank you for your kind response to my letter of May 22nd and the material which you provided.

I failed to indicate in my last letter certain additional information which I desire:

1. I understand that the correct directions to get to the "Boulware Walls" burying ground are as follows"

The cemetery is about nine miles northeast of Winnsboro, and about the same distance north of Ridgeway on U. S. Highway 21, and a few hundred yards to the east. The location may be seen from the Shell Filling Station, which is on Highway 21 at the site of the Frank Boulware home, and of the old Flint Hill Post Office.

2. I understand that William Lewis (b. October 9, 1759 - d. May 18, 1841) is buried in the Lewis-Pickett Graveyard near Mt. Moriah Church.

Could you give me directions for getting there.

3. I understand that the burial place of John Lewis Senior is unknown.

Is my understanding correct? If not, where and how do you get there?

4. I have no knowlege concerning the burial place of Nancy Rae Buchanan, sister-in-law of Captain John Buchanan, and mother-in-law of John Lewis.

Is the place known? If so, where and how do you get there?

You did not indicate what charges and fees applied to the last copies and information you supplied to me. Please let me know and I will remit. Otherwise, what donation is customary to assist you in your work.
