I Gan Thompson of Fairfield District in the state of South Carolina do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made, And as to such worldly estate as At hath pleased god to intrust me with I dispose of the same as follows, First I give to my Daughter Mary the ^{largest} land or plantation whereon I now live. also the Crop that is on it and my stock of horses, Cattle, hogs, Sheep &c. House hold and Kitchen furniture and plantation tools of all descriptions.

and My daughter Mary to support her Mother Jana Thompson as long as she lives, off of the property that I will her above, and in case that she dies before her mother my two grand sons, John and Samuel Thompson to see that their Grand mother is supported off the property as long as she lives, And I do hereby make and ordain Hampton Williams,

Exeutor of this my last will and testament, In witness whereof I set my hand and Seal, this first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty

In the name of God Amen.

I. Robert Thompson of the State and district above mentioned, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following-VIZ First I recommend my Soul to God and my body to the dust, to be buried in a decent christian manner. st It

is my will that all my just debts be paid and my funeral expenses. 2nd It is my will that my Wife Mary Thompson, have a support amongst my children, and provided for by them during her lifetime.

3rd It is my will to give and bequeath to my son Robert Thompson the tract of land purchased from Samuel Stone, containing Sixty acres.

4th It is my will to give and bequeath to my son John Thompson, The tract of land purchased by me from John Roberts, containing fifty two Acres and a half-

5th It is my will to give and bequeath to my son Samuel Thompson, the old original tract of land, whereon I now live, containing one hundred and forty four Acres. I also give to him the following horses Patt and Fill and the mule colt- And also give him all the Stock of cows, except one cow and calf, also, give to him my stock of hogs. also all the house furniture, exception bed.

6th It is my will that my Son James Thompson, live with my son Samuel Thompson, and to be supported and provided for during his life time by him.

7th It is my will to give and bequeath to my daughter Mary McKeown one hundred dollars.

8th It is my will to give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth McKeown, one hundred dollars.

9th It is my will to give and bequeath to my daughter Jennet McKeown, one hundred dollars-

Thompson. all the money, arising from the Sale of the one hundred acres of land, situate in Chester District, given to me by my Father Gaun Thompson, except three hundred dollars. I also give to her ^{and} horse VIZ Duggins also one cow and calf and also one feather bed. And lastly I constitute and appoint Robert Thompson Jr and John Stephenson, son of W^m Stephenson, my Executors. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty Seven. (1837)
