The schools of the Charlemont district were closed for the whole or a part of the day as required January 14, to give the teachers an opportunity to attend the teachers' meeting at Charlemont. Though the traveling was bad and the distances long, every teacher was present except those in N. Adams, it being nearly impossible for them to come and return the same day. An interesting program was arranged by Supr. E. P. Howard, which was listened to by a good number of school commissioners and citizens.

G. T. Fitcher, agent of the state board of education, was present and discussed the subject of school discipline in a very comprehensive, instructive and helpful manner. The teachers of this vicinity are always glad to avail themselves of the privilege of drawing upon Mr. Fitcher's fund of information and experience upon all school topics, and he is sure of a hearty welcome here whenever he can come. Charlemont village has secured the services of Miss Annie Temple as special teacher in music for the remainder of this school year, and her work was exemplified with a class of primary pupils and one of grammar pupils from the village school. Miss Temple is a competent, enthusiastic and inspiring specialist in this branch, and all interested should see her work Tuesdays and Fridays. The results of music teaching in the ungraded schools were illustrated by Miss Mary W. Hager with her school from East Rowe organized as a quartet. The pupils present were Lea Colburn, Louis Tuttle, Leon Wofenden, Edward Upton, Mary White, Maude Hubert, Emma Wilson was prevented from coming by illness. Lisa and Lizzie Temple, of Hawley, pupils of the Glass school in Charlemont this winter, rendered a duet very acceptably. Memory map-drawing was illustrated by the pupils from Charlemont grammar school, the work being upon the map of Massachusetts; the following pupils volunteered to participate in the exercise: Pearl Thayer, Alice Bemis, Annie Gerry, Marlon Hixon, Bessie Rice, and Yarter, the first three were asked to give oral descriptions of their maps. Memory maps were executed and described by Emma Snodder and Herbert Wessman of the Davis mine school in Rowe. Thesetwo took the New England states for their subject and did excellent work. The last exercise was to have been a recitation by the teachers from White's Elements of Pedagogy, conducted by Superintendent Howard, but the lateness of the hour forbade the completion of the program, hence, after brief remarks by Charles Christenson, Esq., chairman of the school board, and Rev. ### SIXTH REGIMENT ELECTIONS.

Lieut Col C. F. Woodward of Wakefield  
Chosen Colonel, Maj G. H. Chaffin of  
Southbridge Lieutenant Colonel.

In accordance with special orders, the line officers of the 6th regiment of infantry assembled at the headquarters of the 1st brigade, M. V. M., South armory, yesterday at 4 o'clock, for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the colonelcy of the regiment caused by the retirement of Col Henry Parsons.

Brig Gen Thomas B. Mathews, commanding the 1st brigade, presided, Lieut Col Hager, assistant adjutant general, acting as recorder. All of the 36 line officers of the command were present.

On the ballot for colonel the unanimous vote was cast for Lieut Col Chas. F. Woodward of Wakefield, and he was declared elected.

The vote for lieutenant colonel was divided between Maj George H. Chaffin of Southbridge, who received 33, and Maj George H. Taylor of Wakefield, who received three votes. Maj Chaffin was pronounced the choice for lieutenant colonel.

The vacancy caused in the quota of majors by these promotions was next considered. Capt William J. Williams, commanding Co I, Boston, the senior captain, announced that he was not a candidate, and on ballot the second senior, Capt George H. Priest, of Co B, Fitchburg, was elected major, receiving 26 votes, as against 19 for Capt Jackson of Co F, Marlboro, and 3 for Capt J. N. Marshall of Co E, South Framingham.

At the conclusion of the election the line officers retired to Copley sq hotel, where they met the field officers, and congratulations were extended the newly elected officers. The officers were in turn entertained at dinner by Col Woodward.

Other special guests were Pres Smith of the state senate, of which body Col Woodward is a member; Brig Gen Mathews and Lieut Gen Hager, assistant adjutant general.

The new officers are all well known in military circles, and have rendered efficient service for the commonwealth.

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During a severe electrical storm the other day Delos Hager, and his son Orlee, 16, of Manlius, N. Y., who were drawing hay, crawled under the loaded wagon. A pitchfork was left standing in the top of the load. The fork attracted a thunderbolt, which, after shattering it, passed through the load, splintering the wagon and killing Hager, his son, and their dog, which had followed them beneath the hay rack, and the horses attached to the wagon.

**WESTMINSTER.**  
**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING.**

A large number of voters and several women attended the special town meeting, Saturday evening. After several elections and refusals to serve for moderator, A. E. Hurd was elected and took the chair.

A motion was made and carried to take up the fifth article first, "to see if the town will vote to purchase the Reed corner, or any portion thereof, for a public library location or act anything relative thereto."

Joseph Hager moved that the town purchase the Reed corner, the house to be moved to some suitable location on Main street. After considerable discussion and statements that the lot could be purchased for \$2500, that \$2500 had been subscribed by individuals, that a lot could be secured on which the building could be placed for the net cost of \$50 and that a responsible party would move the house for \$450. An amendment was made and accepted that the town appropriate \$200 toward the purchase of the lot and disposition of the building, but the motion to buy the lot was lost, 65 to 73.

The third article was then taken up and F. W. Fenno moved that the town accept the Bradley lot, for which the full price had been subscribed. The advantages of the lot were fully presented and the motion to buy the lot was lost, 43 to 95.

A motion was made and carried to reconsider the vote passed on the Reed corner lot and Mr. Hager then renewed his former motion, with the appropriation of \$500, which was carried with little discussion, 77 to 43, and the following committee of construction were chosen: Alonzo Curtis, E. B. Lynde, P. P. Ellis, D. O. Miles, F. H. Battles, Joseph Hager and J. G. Goodridge.

Article 4 was then called up, and it was voted to rescind the vote taken May 11, whereby the Gibbs lot was accepted, and the committee chosen on that date was instructed to deed back the lot, adopting resolutions expressing the thanks of the town for the generous spirit of the donors.

During the evening, by consent of the meeting, Mrs. Whitman gave a brief history of the formation of the library, and told of some of Mr. Forbush's wishes in regard to its future, including the location on the Reed corner.

Article 6 was passed over without any discussion, and the meeting dissolved at 10.30.

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An error in the panel list was found when Otto F. Hager, a Buffalo music dealer, was called for examination. Otto H. Hager, of Grand Island, presented himself instead and he was excused.

**GUIDE KILLED.**

**John Hager Shot by a  
Concord, Mass. Man.**

**Wilfred Wheeler Mistook Him  
for a Deer in Woods.**

**Two Parties Started Out  
in Early Morning.**

**Made No Arrangements as to the  
Direction Each Should Take.**

**Falling Snow Cause of Mistake,  
it is Claimed.**

DOVER, N.H., Nov 13.—John Hager, 51, a guide of this town, was mistaken for a deer and shot and instantly killed yesterday morning by Wilfred Wheeler, a sportsman of Concord, Mass.

The accident happened in the vicinity of the sporting camp owned by John Hager and his brother Frank, on the west branch of the Pennesseet, about 20 miles above Kittery.

A party consisting of William Spillbury of Webster, Wilfred Wheeler of Concord and his brother, Arthur L. Wheeler of Providence, were met by the Hagers at Northport early last Saturday and taken to their camp. They had gone out to hunting and in the previous morning had secured four deer.

The fall of snow in that vicinity amounted on yesterday morning to about two inches, having covered the ground and loaded down the trees. In order to hunt to good advantage, the members of the party divided. Spillbury and Wilfred Wheeler going with Frank Hager, and Arthur Wheeler being guided by John Hager.

The two parties left camp early in the morning without making definite arrangements as to which direction each should take. A short time afterwards one of the parties struck the trail of a deer, and following it they were prospecting the heavily wooded territory of the woods. At that point John Hager was mistaken for a deer and the fatal shot was fired.

The mistake was due to the fact that either party did not know the whereabouts of the other and the snow falling rapidly had covered the land and cut of the signs so that his form was well hidden. Wheeler saw and moved, as he did in the woods, but the falling snow had caused him to mistake the guide for a deer.

Frank Hager, while almost prostrated deer had look upon the error as one of official consideration.

Four hunters were seen in the company of the Wheelers for several days and afterwards they were seen the almost into white hunting.

The dead guide leaves a wife. The body arrived here tonight and an inquest will be held tomorrow.

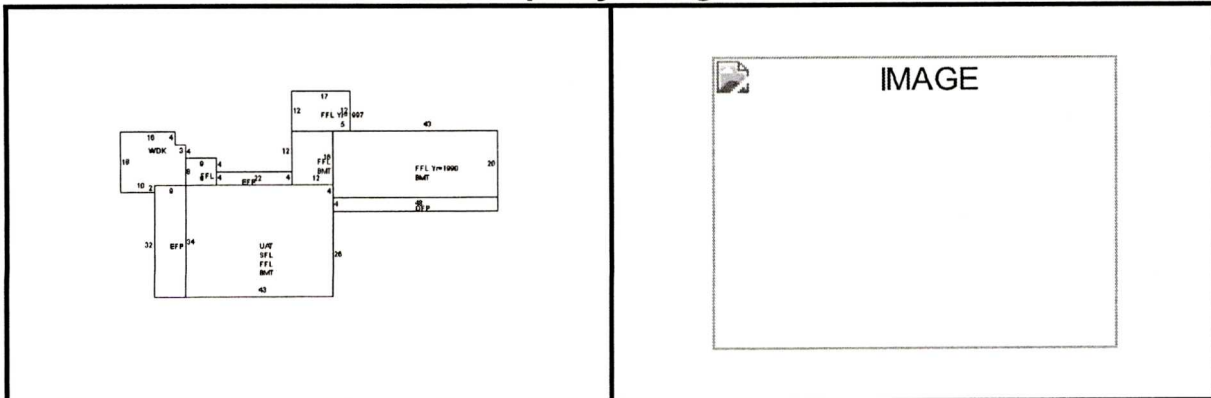
