Regt. on the 11th day of April 1861, and served in that command until the 1st day of August 1862. He was discharged from the service at Franklin, S.C. on the 22nd day of February 1863, and was at that time a member of Company E, 2nd Regt. of 7th Inf. Regt. Battalion of 7th Inf. Regt. Captain John D. Hannon. I was married to him 22nd day of Dec. 1849. My husband did not do the service of the Confederate States nor of this State. My husband died on the 8th day of February 1916. My income from all sources does not exceed \$500.00—does not exceed \$1,000.00. The valuation of all my property does not exceed \$500.00—does not exceed \$1,000.00. I am 70 years of age. I reside at Franklin, S.C. in Franklin County, S. C., and have lived there since the 23rd day of December 1867.

I have not been on the pension roll of South Carolina, nor any other State, nor of the United States.
