granted and Mary Tidwell and David W. Tidwell was  
named as executors on 27 april 1871. Bond was signed  
by L. B. Morrell & Toney Tidwell.

The appraisers of the estate were A. C. Norton, Thomas B. Walker,  
David J. Seigler, Reuben Molliey and John McCauley.

Strother Tidwell departed this life in March 1871 leaving a widow and ten surviving children.

His widow had set off for her the home place on Dutchman Creek adjacent to the land of Fletcher Ruff, Nicholas Peay and Tidwell lands.

She will take this in lieu of any other share in the estate. The Court orders the sale of the other lands and the proceeds to be divided into ten equal shares. one share for each child or the legal heirs of a deceased child.
