Jackson's 1st wife, Jane, b. ca. 1812, d. 10 Dec. 1862, is buried at Ebenezer U.S. Meth. Ch. at Rossville, near Great Falls, SC (Chester Co.). She & Jackson had a son, Calvin, b. ca. 1835. He may be bur. next to Jane in an unmarked grave.

In 1846, spring term, Jackson Tidwell sued Elijah Graham (2971) in Equity Court for \$25⁰⁰. Graham agreed to pay.

Oct. 1848 - Jackson was arrested for beating a slave. No trial - Ct. of Genl. Sessions, Fairfield Co.

In 1882, Jackson was "converted to the church at Bethel" (From family Bible -)

In 1900, Nannie had a boarding house in Newberry. In 1913, she was living at Watts Mill in Laurens, SC, as was her son, Milton.
