



- 1900 - John, Carrie & "Willie" were in Laurens, SC - probably at Watts Mill. His sister, Nannie, was also in Laurens, but living independently.
- 1910 - John, Carrie & 4 children were in Spartanburg, SC, probably at Draughton Mill.
- 1912-13 - John & family were in Hartselle, AL (poss. for training for John?)
- 1914 - John & family returned to Greenville, SC, to Judson Mill.
- 1916-19 - John moved about & up in Green, Monaghan, Duress & Judson Mills. He became overseer at Judson Mill in 1919, as did his brother, Floyd.
- 1925 - John became Superintendent at both Judson Mills.
- 1927 - He died of "blood poisoning" at age 48.
