From Newberry Courthouse:

1. (a) Sallie's will, signed 8-27-1907, and filed 3-1907 — In. Box 185, Pkg. 32 — Exec.: J. Brooks Wingard, Sallie's "friend". Charlie B. to receive  $\frac{1}{4}$  her estate and her mother, Ann Kinkle, to receive  $\frac{3}{4}$ . On all to go to her mother if Charlie died first. Wit.: W. H. Wilkes, Lula R. Wingard & Lucie D. Wingard.  
Sallie's date of death: 2-21-1908.

(b) Records, re: Sallie bought land from Charlie B., 8-23-1905, via a one-year note for \$300<sup>00</sup> at 8% interest.

2. (a) Petition of Maggie Senn — In. Box 191, Pkg. 42 — Asked the court to make James B. Senn guardian of her minor son, Jackson Tidwell, 5/6 Chas. B. Tidwell, deceased. Stated that Jackson was living with her and that Jackson had an interest in the estate of Chas. B. Tidwell, deceased, amounting to \$188<sup>36</sup>. Petition dated 12-7-1910. Wit.: J. B. Senn, J. D. Senn, J. J. Langford before Col. L. Blaise, NPSC.

(b) James B. Senn appointed guardian of Jackson Tidwell by judge of probates, 12-7-1910.
