S.C. with his parents. He served in Revolution (Does not who in #5) and died in 1782 when killed in Battle...His wife Mary De Graffenreid died soon after...They left two children:

Benjamin Tidwell b. 1782 William Tidwell b. 1780
These children were brought by relatives to Green Co. Ga. and later came to Putnam Co. and later removed to Merriwether Co. The McCall-Tidwell book deals with the families of this branch.

Charles Lewis...Peter Tidwell made oath as to his service 4th Dec 1783...An Indent #607Q was issued in payment for this service...I know that Lt. James Pickett resided in the Longtown area of Fairfield Co. S.C. and I judge this was also the residence of Peter Tidwell...Andrea. 16-a. Elbert Co. Ga.

Jesse Holbrook and his wife, Susanna Holbrook...a deed sg. 27 Dec 1792 to PETER TIDWELL...100a land on Beaverdam Creek originally granted in 1785 to John Tollett who sold same to Holbrook /Wit. Robert Ballenger & Robert Brown before B.Pass J.P. COMMENT:

Here by 1792 was find PETER TIDWELL buying lands in Elbert Co. Ga. some 9 years after he filed his Revolutionary claim in S.C. in 1783... We do not find PETER TIDWELL selling this 100a of land he purchased...The land was likely in a portion of Elbert that that out off into some other county e. g. Jackson Co.

We then drove to Winnsboro and ate dinner...Then to the Woodward Cemetary where we stopped and them to Chester SC and thence to Lockhart SC...A couple of miles before we got to Lockhart we saw the old road leading to the cow pasture in which the old Irish Cemetery is located...From Lockhart SC we drove to Union SC and thence to Whitmire, SC and from there over a newly paved road to Pomaris where we all stopped at the old St. John Luthern Church which was built in 1768...Then we came on to Columbia after a very enjoyable jaunt.
