in West Morelan Countie planter doe acknowledge to have received of James Tune of Rappa Countie ten head of cattle the mark being over keill in both ears being the female increase of four caves which was left Ann given as a legacie by Richard Powell deceased in the custody of James Tune for the proper use of Anna Barnett (the daughter of Peter Barnett and daughter in-law of the above mentioned Richard Powell) and to be delivered unto her at the age of 17 years or at her age of marriage. Now know yee that I richard Tydwell being the husband of said Anna Barnett doe for her and for myself have or my heirs exrs and administrators from this forward and forever by these presents discharge and acquit the said James Tune his heirs, exrs, and administrators from the said cattle above mentioned, and from any other claim that have been or shall be made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of May 1674."
