records show that her second husband, Lockley Connelin, by 1703 had a wife named Sarah.

We have very little information concerning the children of Richard (I) and Anna Barnett Tidwell except for the two sons, Richard (II) and Robert. The scant facts about the others will be shown first, followed by data concerning Robert. Lastly will come the more pertinent information concerning Richard (II) from whom we descend.

According to W.A. Tidwell, Jr., in his article entitled "Presley Tidwell and the Anti-Carter Faction in the Northern Neck", Martha Tydwell married James Lane and they had a son, William, born in 1693. This information is based on data from Lane descendants. Records show that on April 28, 1698, the Westmoreland Court ordered that Robert Tydwell remain with James Lane and Martha, his wife, until he reached the age of seventeen. (Order Book 1698-1705).

By 1699 Martha Tydwell Lane had been widowed and had remarried. In August of that year permission was granted to Andrew Delabree, her new husband, to administer the estate of her late husband, James Lane. That Martha was a daughter of Richard (I) and Anna Barnett Tydwell is pinpointed by the information contained in the court records that she had a natural child and for this indiscretion she was fined 500 pounds of tobacco. Her fine was paid by her brother, Richard Tydwell (II) and a Mr. Wiggins.
