

8. 25 August 1769, 100 acres -- Robert Tidwell.
9. 13 October 1769, return made by Robert X. Tidwell for 100 acres on Hog Fork of Wateree Creek, surveyed by Richard Winn 27 February 1768 for Richard Tidwell.
10. October 1769, return by Robert X. Tidwell for himself 100 acres on Hog Fork of Wateree Creek, Craven County and surveyed 22 February 1769 by Richard Winn.
11. May 1772, 200 acres Fork Wateree Creek -- Prescott (Presley?) Tidwell.
12. 19 November 1772, 300 acres Fork Wateree Creek -- John Tidwell (300 acres at Hog Fork on Wateree Creek to John Runnels 18 March 1776).
13. November 1772 to John Tidwell (100 acres to George Lott 9 August 1789).
14. August 1772, 200 acres surveyed on Wateree Creek at the Fork, the South Fork called Hog, survey by John Gaston and return made 3 December 1772 by Richard Winn for Prescott (Presley?) Tidwell.
15. 23 May 1764, 150 acres on South Fork of Wateree Creek for Richard Tidwell -- survey made by John Gaston. Return made 22 May 1764 by Ely Kershaw.
16. 1 January, Rachel Tidwell (widow) sold her home place to Bird Owen (deeded 100 acres of grant to Richard Tidwell 29 April 1768 on Hog Fork of Wateree Creek).
17. 5 January 1795, Rachel Tidwell (widow) bill of sale for
