And County of Fairfield; being very sick and weak in Body, but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be given unto God for the Same and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed once for all Men to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament (That is to say) Principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of God that give all; And for my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors, Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection; I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God; and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life.
