(p.817) 18 Jun 1728.... Ralph Jackson of Lyons Creek Parish to Robert Hix of the same.... 25 acres on north side of Maherin River in Lyons Creek Parish and bounded by the said Hix and Henry Wyche (being land granted said Ralph Jackson on 11 Jul 1719).

Wit: Thomas Eldridge.

(p.819) 7 Jun 1728.... William Thompson and wife, Martha Thompson, to their daughter, Katherine King, for Love and Affection.... 150 acres (being the upper corner of 460 acres granted "my father, William Thompson", on 22 Sep 1682) bounded by Mr. John Spraty and the Sypress Swamp. Should Katherine King die without issue or not live on the land; it is to go to Hannah Thompson for life or to John Thompson or Samuel Thompson, Jr.

(p.820) 17 Jan 1727.... Edward Tanner and William Tanner to Samuel Hargrave for 1000 pounds tobacco.... 150 acres in Lawnes Creek Parish now in the tenure of Jacob Cornwell who has a lease for 99 years.

Wit: James Vaughan, John (X) Bruce and William (X) SewardEdward (X) Tanner

(p.820) 2 Apr 1728.... William Hamlin of Prince George County to John Bell of Surry County.... 235 acres on both sides of Spring Swamp on the south side of Nottoway River.

(p.822) 18 Jun 1728.... John Carter to Benjamin Willard.... 190 acres on south side of Nottoway River (this first land is bounded by George Reeves, John Brooks, Hinshaw Maybray and the College land) and 400 acres on the south side of Nottoway River (being land bounded by John Gillium, Hinshaw Maybray, Moores Swamp and said Carter).

Wit: James Baker and John Chapman.

(p.825) 15 May 1728.... Processioners of Southwarke Parish state that George Norwood refused to acknowledge the line between his land and William Cocke. The court defines the line.

(p.827) 3 Jun 1728.... Elizabeth Warren and William Warren to Robert Warren for 50 pounds sterling.... 290 acres (being the land Robert Warren lives on) in Southwarke Parish bounded by Sion Hill, Ogburn, Ailen Warren, Wild Swamp, Hogpen Swamp and Elizabeth Thomas.

(p.829) 3 Jul 1728.... Elizabeth Warren and Robert Warren to William Warren for 50 pounds sterling.... 360 acres (being the land William Warren lives on) in Southwarke Parish bounded by Hull Cabbins Swamp, Pylant, Wooff Pit Pond, Sion Hill and Shee Cabbins Branch.
