

for her to give her home up, after she had lived such a long and active life, and to sit down and do nothing. She lived many years after this and died the year before I was married, 1883. We took her to our family burying ground and placed her beside our grandfather and thus-- all ended in death. It is up to we grandchildren and great grandchildren to remember and recall the events of her life and to remember August 12th, 1805- Grandmother's birthday. This date with a lock of her hair is recorded in my family Bible which has been placed in the University of Missouri Library, a fire-proof building. I often write to some of my cousins on this date lest we forget this little family history I have told, hoping it will reach the hearts and revive their memories. There are many other things that I may write some day, but not today. If I should not- then remember that I meant to.
