for her to give her home up, after she had lived such a long and active life, and to sit down and do nothing. She lived many years after this and died the year before I was married, 1883. We took her to our family burying ground and placed her beside our grandfather and thus—all ended in death. It is up to we grandchildren and great grandchildren to remember and recall the events of her life at the remember August 12th, 1805—Grandmother's birthday. This tate with a lock of her hair is recorded in my family Bible which has been placed in the University of Missouri Library, a fire-proof wilding. I often write to some of my cousins on this date less we forget this little family history I have told, hoping it will reach hearts and revive their memories.
